Art Works (L, B, K, IL) – Campers will explore aspects of acrylic painting with popular Instructor Darwin Murphy. **Ages 8-12**

Dinosaur Detectives (L, B, K, IL) – Campers will experience fun arts, crafts, and movement based activities that center on dinosaurs. Students will learn about different dinosaurs while making fun crafts such as creating fossils, excavating dinos from ice, making costumes, and dancing, with Instructor Dana Dupre. **Ages 5-8**

Incredible Edibles (L, B, K, IL) - Campers will engage in a unique food and health course, featuring fruit, veggies, grains and proteins! Come ready to EXPLORE each of these groups with fun games, some art (constructing a grain), blind taste testing and growing our own food! We will also put on our chef hats to make OUR OWN AWESOME SNACKS each day with Instructor Katey Powell. **Ages 5-12**

Kidz Fitness Zone (L, B, K, IL) - Campers will learn practical lifestyle interventions to prevent chronic health conditions later in life. They will learn basic life support, healthy cooking tips, and some exercises from Instructor Patricia Jones. **Ages 5-12**

Magic of Science (L, B, K, IL) - Campers will create homemade science projects like bottle rockets, clouds in a jar, invisible ink, slime, as well as learn about color theory with Instructor Dana Dupre. **Ages 8-12**

Minecraft: The Performance (L, B, K, IL) - Campers will use the martial arts, dance, and music to create a Minecraft style performance piece. Let the dance battle begin! Instructor Amanda Ghent. **Ages 7-12**

Minecraft: The Stage (L, B, K, IL) - Campers will set the stage for their own life-sized Minecrafted world. Campers will design and create an interactive world in which to play, perform and enjoy! Instructor Sensei Connie Funderburk. **Ages 7-12**

The Friendly Bracelet (L, B, K, IL) - Campers will learn several styles of friendship bracelet making. Focusing on the use of embroidery floss and techniques to create lasting bracelets with multiple, vibrant color, with Instructor David Kellin. **Ages 7-12**

Wonder of Watercolor (L, B, K, IL) - Campers will be able to create beautiful, eye-catching works of art using watercolor and black glue! These stained glass window-inspired pieces will showcase creativity and artistic skill, with Instructor Drew Griffin. **Ages 7-12**

Explore the World - Through the Artist Lense (L, B, IL) - Campers will look at life through an artist and scientist lenses as they swim under the sea, explore the jungle, swing through the amazon and navigate the Safari with Instructor Ashley Helgeson. **Ages 5-12**

Hands on Music (L, B, IL) – Campers will learn to sing and play fun and exciting tunes with drums and other percussion and wind instruments with Music Instructor Branten Blair. **Ages 5-12**

Gourds, Gourds, Gourds! (L, B, K) - Campers will create their own unique piece of art made from a gourd, and learn all about gourds, with Instructor Patricia Peterson. **Ages 9-12**

Catch the Light (L, IL) - Campers will be instructed on how light plays with glass, and the different aspects of how light can change and alter color through it. Using glass, the campers will create unique art with Instructor Randy Cikowski. **Ages 7-12**

Hands On Illusions (L, IL) – Campers will learn the art of illusion, using art to create whimsical, imaginative crafts that prove to be more than what they see with Instructor Randy Cikowski. **Ages 7-12**
